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BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS

Commissioner Dale Hurley called the meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners (BOC) of the Plainfield Fire Protection District to order on Wednesday, February 4, 2026, at 8:30 a.m. at the PFPD Headquarters (HQ), 23748 W. 135th St., Plainfield, IL, with the Pledge of Allegiance. Those in attendance were Commissioner Dale Hurley, Commissioner Steven Iovinelli & Commissioner Arnold Hartley (arriving at 8:45 a.m.), as well as Deputy Chief Charles Kraft, Human Resources Alicia Pavone & Administrative Assistant Nicole Irwin.

A motion was made to accept the January 15, 2026, meeting minutes by Commissioner Dale Hurley; seconded by Commissioner Steve Iovinelli; motion approved by a 2-0 voice vote.

Old Business: The lieutenant promotional process applications were reviewed. A total of 10 candidates submitted applications, with the due date set for Friday. Discussion was held regarding the timing of the 90-day notice. The chiefs have completed updates to the Standard Operating Guidelines and Procedures. The notice will be sent later this month.

The Board reviewed paperwork for nine new hires currently in the pre-employment process. A detailed discussion was held regarding one candidate. **A motion was made to accept eight of the nine candidates and pass on one candidate by Commissioner Dale Hurley, seconded by Commissioner Arnold Hartley. The motion was approved by a 3-0 voice vote.**

Human Resource Director Alicia Pavone explained that the psychological examination is the next step in the process and requested approval to proceed with scheduling physical examinations upon receipt of the psychologist's documentation. **A motion was made to approve scheduling the next step contingent upon a positive recommendation by Commissioner Arnold Hartley, seconded by Commissioner Steve Iovinelli. The motion was approved by a 3-0 voice vote.**

Commissioners requested a quote from the firefighter eligibility testing company. They would like to move forward with testing again, possibly in June 2026.

A special meeting was discussed and will have to be held before the next quarterly meeting. Once the documentation is back for review, a meeting will be scheduled.

The next quarterly meeting will be held on Wednesday, April 15, 2026, at 8:30 a.m. at HQ. **There being no further business, a motion was made by Commissioner Dale Hurley to adjourn the meeting at 9:45 p.m., seconded by Commissioner Steve Iovinelli; all in favor.**
