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BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS

Commissioner Dale Hurley called the meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners (BOC) of the Plainfield Fire Protection District to order on Wednesday, April 15, 2026, at 8:30 a.m. at the PFPD Headquarters (HQ), 23748 W. 135th St., Plainfield, IL, with the Pledge of Allegiance. Those in attendance were Commissioner Dale Hurley, Commissioner Steven Iovinelli & Commissioner Arnold Hartley. As well as Trustee Robert Dehm, Chief Vito Bonomo, Deputy Chief Charles Kraft, Human Resources Alicia Pavone & Administrative Assistant Nicole Irwin.

A motion was made to accept the February 4, 2026, meeting minutes by Commissioner Dale Hurley; seconded by Commissioner Steve Iovinelli; motion approved by a 3-0 voice vote.

Old Business: Discussion and review of documentation from testing companies. After reviewing pricing and the process, a decision was made to go with I/O Solutions / Public Safety Testing (IOS/PST) for firefighter eligibility testing. **A motion was made to utilize IOS/PST for eligibility testing by Commissioner Steve Iovinelli; seconded by Commissioner Arnold Hartley; motion approved by a 3-0 voice vote.**

Chief Bonomo reported that the new hires are now in their second week of training, and everything is progressing well. He also noted that he and HR representative Alicia Pavone have decided to switch to a new provider for company physicals. This change was made due to delays with the current provider, whose long turnaround times were pushing back the start of the hiring process. Commissioner Steve Iovinelli will do the Oath of Office tonight, April 15th, at headquarters for the six new hires.

A review of the lieutenant promotional testing components was conducted, and the interview questions were finalized. **A motion was made to update the interview questions with the ones selected in the meeting by Commissioner Steve Iovinelli; seconded by Commissioner Dale Hurley, motion approved by a 3-0 voice vote.**

A special meeting to conduct Lieutenant Promotional testing interviews will be held on Thursday, May 21, 2026, at 8:30 a.m. The next quarterly meeting will be held on Wednesday, July 15, 2026, at 8:30 a.m. at HQ. **There being no further business, a motion was made by Commissioner Dale Hurley to adjourn the meeting at 9:11 a.m., seconded by Commissioner Arnold Hartley; all in favor.**
