BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS

Commissioner Dale Hurley called the meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners (BOC) of the Plainfield Fire Protection District to order on, Wednesday, January 15, 2025, at 8:30 a.m. at the PFPD Headquarters (HQ), 23748 W. 135th St., Plainfield, IL, with the Pledge of Allegiance. Those in attendance were Commissioner Dale Hurley, Commissioner Arnold Hartley & Commissioner Robert Dehm. As well as Chief Vito Bonomo, Deputy Chief Charles Kraft, Administrative Assistant Nicole Irwin, & HR Generalist Alicia Pavone.

A motion was made to accept the October 16, 2024, meeting minutes by Commissioner Robert Dehm, seconded by Commissioner Dale Hurley; motion approved by a 3-0 voice vote.

No bills or matters from the public.

Old Business: Reviewed the testing company submissions; RMA, IO Solutions and National Testing Network all submitted for firefighter eligibility testing. The Commissioners and Chief all want the online written exam option, which would rule out RMA. After reviewing pricing, they decided to move forward with IO Solutions. An email will be sent moving forward with setting up dates and times. Discussion held on application price and possibly testing annually instead of every other year, will look into the state regulations.

-Chief discussed in home visits similar to Morris FD, he will call and get more details. He will also contact Carpentersville FD to see how NTN did for their testing needs.

-Will contact RMA for further information on the dates for Battalion Chief Promotional testing starting in the summer/fall.

-The Rules & Regulations that were adopted last meeting, were reviewed with the addition of the letters of intent for promotional testing, all is finalized.

New Business: The 2024 Commission Report was reviewed and is ready to be given to the Board of Trustees for their next meeting.

-Chief Bonomo is passing on the testing process to Deputy Chief Kraft for the year, all questions will go through him.

-Alicia will be requesting State approval for destruction of past applications and closed session recordings.

The next meeting will be held on Wednesday, April 16, 2025, at 8:30 a.m. at HQ. **There being no further business, a motion was made by Commissioner Dale Hurley to adjourn the meeting at 9:12 a.m., seconded by Commissioner Arnold Hartley; all in favor.**
