



# PLAINFIELD FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

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## BOARD OF FIRE TRUSTEES WORKSHOP MEETING

President Baish called the special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Plainfield Fire Protection District to order at 11:00 a.m., held on Friday, June 13, 2025, at the Fire District Headquarters, 23748 W. 135<sup>th</sup> St., Plainfield, IL, with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A roll call attendance was taken: Trustee Bob Dehm – present; Trustee Doug Shreve – present; Trustee Bob Baish – present. Trustee Bill Klein was absent.

Chief Vito Bonomo, Deputy Chief Mark Reynolds, Deputy Chief Chuck Kraft, Attorney John Motylinski, and Administrative Assistant Mary Jo Fazio were also in attendance.

President Baish announced that Trustee Tom Paul has resigned from the Board. He thanked Tom for his 10 years of service in the District and for the impact he had.

**Open Forum** – Nothing from the audience.

**Old Business** – Nothing for old business.

**New Business** – Due to the resignation of Trustee Tom Paul, there is a vacant position on the Board to fill the remaining 2-year term held by Tom. After a brief conversation, **Trustee Shreve motioned to appoint Ted Peszynski to fill the vacancy for the remaining 2-year term, seconded by Trustee Dehm. A roll call vote was taken: Trustee Dehm – yes; Trustee Shreve – yes; Trustee Baish – yes. Motion carried.**

President Baish gave the Oath of Office to Ted Peszynski.

Chief Bonomo and Fire Marshal Ryan Angelus explained the changes in Ordinance 25-0613, an Ordinance adopting Fire Prevention Codes for the Plainfield Fire Protection District, to the Board. After some discussion, **Trustee Peszynski motioned to approve Ordinance 25-0613 as presented, seconded by Trustee Dehm. A roll call vote was taken: Trustee Peszynski – yes; Trustee Baish – yes; Trustee Shreve – yes; Trustee Dehm – yes. Motion carried.**

Chief Bonomo stated that the following sealed bids were received for the Headquarters front entry construction / remodel project: (1) Demolition – Richard Kubinski Excavating, \$93,000.00, and J Russ & Company, \$78,629.62; (2) Concrete & Excavation – Concrete by Wagner, Inc., \$147,690.00; (3) Electrical – Elliott Electric, \$43,579.00 and Indicom Electric, \$39,750.00; (4) Landscape & Hardscape – KD Landscape, \$75,000.00. Narvick Bros. presented the total cost estimate for the front entry project for \$538,549.15. **Trustee Shreve motioned to approve the following subcontractors from the sealed bids received: J Russ & Company, Concrete by Wagner, Inc., Indicom Electric, and KD Landscape, and to accept the total cost estimate as presented by Narvick Bros., seconded by Trustee Dehm. A roll call vote was taken: Trustee Peszynski – yes; Trustee Baish – yes; Trustee Shreve – yes; Trustee Dehm – yes. Motion carried.**

**Trustee Shreve motioned to adjourn to a closed session at 11:23 a.m. to discuss any lawful purpose permitted by the Open Meeting Act – 5ILCS 120/2, seconded by Trustee Peszynski. A roll call vote was taken: Trustee Peszynski – yes; Trustee Baish – yes; Trustee Shreve – yes; Trustee Dehm - yes. Motion carried.**

**The regular meeting was reconvened at 11:41 a.m. by a motion from a closed session. Discussions were held regarding property acquisitions. No decisions were made.**

The next regular meeting is Tuesday, July 8, 2025, at 11:00 a.m.

**There being no further business, Trustee Shreve motioned to adjourn the meeting at 11:43 a.m., seconded by Trustee Dehm, all in favor. Motion carried.**
