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BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS

Commissioner Dale Hurley called the meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners (BOC) of the Plainfield Fire Protection District to order on Thursday, January 15, 2026, at 8:30 a.m. at the PFPD Headquarters (HQ), 23748 W. 135th St., Plainfield, IL, with the Pledge of Allegiance. Those in attendance were Commissioner Dale Hurley, Commissioner Arnold Hartley & Commissioner Steven Iovinelli, as well as Chief Vito Bonomo, Deputy Chief Charles Kraft, Human Resources Alicia Pavone & Administrative Assistant Nicole Irwin.

A motion was made to accept the November 21, 2025, meeting minutes by Commissioner Dale Hurley; seconded by Commissioner Steve Iovinelli; motion approved by a 3-0 voice vote.

Old Business: The Commission reviewed the quote submitted by Resource Management Associates for the lieutenant promotional testing process. **A motion was made by Commissioner Steve Iovinelli to approve Resource Management Associates to conduct the lieutenant promotional testing, seconded by Commissioner Arnold Hartley. The motion passed by a 3-0 voice vote.** Applications will be emailed to eligible firefighter/paramedics, who will have two weeks to respond if they intend to test for the lieutenant exam. The required 90-day notice will be distributed in March.

The Chief provided an update on the nine firefighter/paramedics who have been offered positions and are currently progressing through the pre-employment process. A special meeting will be scheduled once all background investigations are complete for Commission review and approval. The Chief also suggested considering administering another eligibility test before the current list expires, potentially in the fall. Additionally, the Chief discussed clarifying the validity period of the CPAT. **A motion was made by Commissioner Arnold Hartley to update the wording for the next eligibility test to specify that the CPAT is valid for two years from the date on the card and must be valid at the time of offer, seconded by Commissioner Steve Iovinelli. The motion passed by a 3-0 voice vote.**

New Business: The swearing-in of Matthew Mullins as lieutenant is scheduled for January 19, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. Commissioner Arnold Hartley presented his 2025 Annual BOC Report for submission to the Board of Trustees. **A motion was made by Commissioner Steve Iovinelli to approve the report as presented, seconded by Commissioner Dale Hurley. The motion passed by a 3-0 voice vote.**

The next quarterly meeting will be held on Wednesday, April 15, 2026, at 8:30 a.m. at HQ. **There being no further business, a motion was made by Commissioner Dale Hurley to adjourn the meeting at 9:15 p.m., seconded by Commissioner Arnold Hartley; all in favor.**
