

ORDINANCE NO. 22-0510

**AN ORDINANCE RE-ESTABLISHING AMBULANCE AND RELATED CHARGES
OF THE PLAINFIELD FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Plainfield Fire District (the "District") is a fire protection district duly organized under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the District has full power to pass all necessary ordinances, and rules and regulations for the proper management and conduct of the business of the Board of Trustees of the District for carrying into effect the objects for which the District was funded under 70 ILCS 705/6; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the District has previously established ambulance and related charges in Ordinance Number 16-0823; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is necessary to modify ambulance and related charges due to its increased costs and needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Plainfield Fire Protection District as follows:

Section 1. A fee will be charged for emergency medical services rendered by the Plainfield Fire Protection District. All persons provided with ambulance service by the District or any fire protection district or municipality which provides emergency medical services to the District pursuant to a contract or mutual aid agreement with the District will be charged as follows:

Basic Life Support	\$3,156.00
Advanced Life Support	\$3,156.00
Advanced Life Support Full Code	\$3,156.00
Non-transport fee where treatment is administered	\$ 100.00
Mileage Charge	\$ 17.50 per mile, 5 mile minimum
Supplies	Billed at District's cost

Beginning on January 1, 2023, and each successive January 1st thereafter, the fees set forth in Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be increased without any further action by the Board of

Trustees by the greater of (1) three percent (3%), or (2) the then-existing ambulance billing rate(s) approved by the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services pursuant to any subsequent Cost Report(s) submitted by the District under the GEMT Program or otherwise. The Fire Chief is directed and authorized to update the aforementioned fees upon any subsequent changes to the District's approved ambulance billing rate(s) under the GEMT Program, such update shall be subject to the approval or ratification by the Board. All revenue from the charges assessed pursuant to the emergency response portions of this Ordinance shall be credited to the Corporate Fund of the District.

Section 2. The Chief of the District, or designee, is authorized to assess the foregoing charges and to take any and all reasonable steps in the collection of the same.

Section 3. The Chief of the District, or designee, is authorized to adopt administrative regulations to implement this Ordinance and is authorized to waive any and all of the fees due to a person, business, or other entity under this Ordinance. The Chief, or designee, may do so by policy or on an individual basis.


Section 4. The provisions of this Ordinance shall supersede any prior ordinances establishing charges which are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of the date of passage.

Section 6. If any section, paragraph or provisions of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.


