BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS

Commissioner Dale Hurley called the meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Plainfield Fire Protection District to order on Wednesday, April 20, 2022 at 2:00 p.m. at the PFPD Headquarters, 23748 W. 135th St., Plainfield, IL, with the Pledge of Allegiance. Those in attendance were Commissioner Dale Hurley, Commissioner Arnold Hartley, Commissioner Robert Dehm, Chief Jon Stratton, Deputy Chief Mark Reynolds, Deputy Chief Vito Bonomo and Administrative Assistant Nicole Irwin.

A motion was made to accept the January 19, 2022 meeting minutes by Commissioner Dale Hurley, seconded by Commissioner Robert Dehm; motion approved by a 3-0 voice vote.

No bills or matters from the public.

Old Business: Discussed the requirements and preference points for the firefighter/paramedic eligibility list. A motion was made to update the paramedic requirement from at time of application to at time of hire by Commissioner Arnold Hartley, seconded by Commissioner Robert Dehm; motion approved by 3-0 voice vote. Commissioners approved the preference points with the updated information about explorers added to the "experience points". Chief Stratton gave a quick update on the two candidates that are going through the hiring process, they still need to complete their physicals.

New Business: Commissioner Robert Dehm was welcomed and congratulated as being the new fire commissioner. Commissioners Hartley and Hurley suggested inviting the union to the next workshop meeting to review the Battalion Chief testing procedure.

The next workshop meeting will be held on Wednesday, June 15, 2022 at 2:00 p.m. at HQ. There being no further business, a motion was made by Commissioner Dale Hurley to adjourn the meeting at 2:22 p.m., seconded by Commissioner Arnold Hartley; all in favor.
