BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS

Commissioner Dale Hurley called the meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners (BOC) of the Plainfield Fire Protection District to order on Wednesday, August 10, 2022 at 2:30 p.m. at the PFPD Headquarters, 23748 W. 135th St., Plainfield, IL, with the Pledge of Allegiance. Those in attendance were Commissioner Dale Hurley, Commissioner Arnold Hartley, Commissioner Robert Dehm, Chief Jon Stratton, Deputy Chief Vito Bonomo and Administrative Assistant Nicole Irwin.

A motion was made to accept the July 27, 2022 meeting minutes by Commissioner Robert Dehm, seconded by Commissioner Dale Hurley; motion approved by a 3-0 voice vote.

No bills or matters from the public.

Old Business: Reviewed preference points turned in for firefighter eligibility test. A motion was made to finalize the firefighter eligibility list with preference points added to the scores, by Commissioner Dale Hurley, seconded by Commissioner Arnold Hartley; motion approved by a 3-0 voice vote. A motion was made to approve the fire chief to hire up to six firefighter/paramedics off of the eligibility list, by Commissioner Robert Dehm, seconded by Commissioner Arnold Hartley; motion approved by a 3-0 voice vote.

Deputy Chief Bonomo gave an update on the battalion chief (BC) promotional testing components from the meeting with the testing company on August 9th. An email will be sent to the four lieutenants who will be taking the test with dates and instructions. Chief Stratton will reach out to an outside chief for the interviews. Dates will be sent to the union executive board so that they can work with the district for the validation committee and have union representation at the other components of the BC testing process. BC interviews will be in seniority order and the assessment center and written exam numbers will be drawn by a lotto with numbers given to candidates at their interview.

New Business: No new business.

The next workshop meeting will be held on Wednesday September 14, 2022 at 8:30 a.m. for battalion chief interviews at HQ. There being no further business, a motion was made by Commissioner Dale Hurley to adjourn the meeting at 3:02 p.m., seconded by Commissioner Robert Dehm; all in favor.
