

## **Board of Fire Commissioners' Position**

### **Filling a Vacant Position**

The Board of Trustees is accepting letters of interest from Plainfield Fire Protection District residents for the Board of Fire Commissioners (BOFC) position until Friday, May 1, 2026. Statutory qualifications are outlined in 70ILCS705/16.02 and /16.03. The Board will select the appointee at the May 12, 2026, meeting, with the term starting in June 2026.

There are three (3) commissioners appointed by the elected trustees of the district, each serving staggered 3-year terms.

Generally, the BOFC meets quarterly, but that schedule is directly affected during the years that recruitment and/or promotional testing is conducted or when commissioner involvement is required in disciplinary proceedings. Those testing obligations may substantially increase the number of meetings and require a significant level of commitment to participation.

Additionally, 16 hours of continuing education (CE) are required by September 1 of the following year after appointment to the board. There are numerous opportunities throughout the year to obtain additional training and certification as a commissioner. These opportunities generally occur on evenings and weekends.

This position is voluntary and receives an annual stipend.

The Board of Fire Commissioners' (BOFC) duties include establishing policies and oversight for recruiting, testing, selecting, and promoting all members covered under its authority. The Commission establishes guidelines and procedures for hearings required for discipline and termination of members of the District covered by its authority. They also serve as an appeal or hearing board for District members disciplined or terminated under guidelines established by these rules. The BOFC is guided by, and has other powers and duties as provided by the Illinois Compiled Statutes.
