NOTICE TO BID

The Plainfield Fire Protection District is currently seeking bids for the removal of existing flooring and the installation of a new double broadcast quartz flooring system in Station 4's apparatus garage, located at 15930 S. Frederick Street, Plainfield, Illinois 60585. The bid package with specifications is available on the fire district website www.plainfieldfpd.org or in person at the Plainfield Fire Protection District Administrative building, 23748 W. 135th Street, Plainfield, Illinois 60544 during regular business hours (8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.).

A **mandatory** site visit will be held on Friday, April 24, 2026, **promptly** at 9:00 a.m. Those arriving after 9:00 a.m. will not be allowed entry or allowed to bid on the project. The flooring area consists of approximately 5,000 square feet; however, contractors are responsible for taking their own measurements at the time of the site visit.

Deadline: The sealed bids must be received **no later than Friday, May 8, 2026, at 2:00 p.m.** at the District's Administrative Building, 23748 W. 135th Street, Plainfield, IL 60544.

Marking: Sealed envelopes must be clearly marked "St. 4 Apparatus Garage."

Bid Opening: Bid opening will occur on **Friday, May 8, 2026, at 2:15 p.m.** Bidders do not need to be present. The bid award announcement will be made on Tuesday, May 12, 2026, at 11:00 a.m. at the scheduled Board of Trustees' meeting.

Late proposals will not be accepted under any circumstances. Any proposal(s) received after the scheduled time for closing will be returned to the proposing firm unopened. Sole responsibility rests with the proposing firm to see that its proposal is received on time.

The Plainfield Fire Protection District reserves the right to reject any or all bids on any basis.

The successful bidder will be required to supply a Performance Bond within ten (10) calendar days of acceptance of the bidder's proposal by the Plainfield Fire Protection District. The bond shall be 100% of the total contract price.
